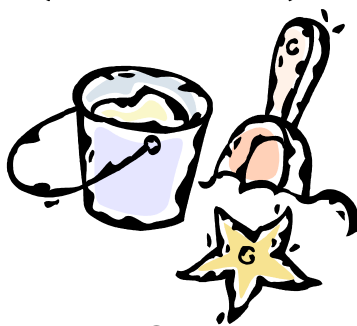

DARC SUMMER DAY CAMP CONTRACT
